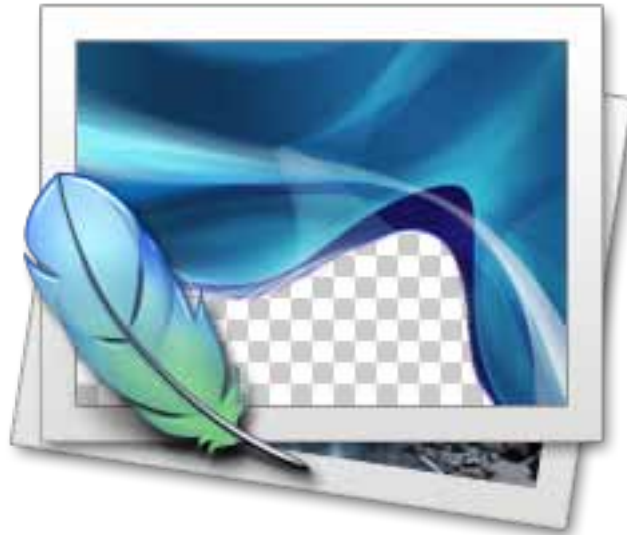
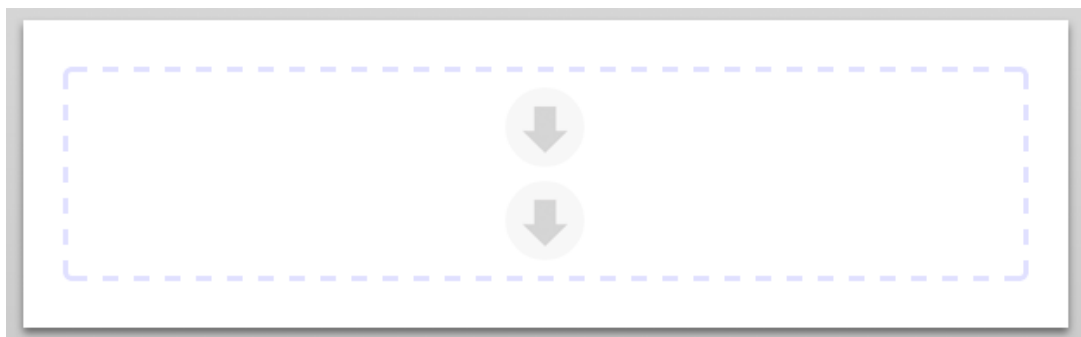


Image Slider is a easy and flexible stack for RapidWeaver.

With this brief manual and the movie on my website (www.idsign-shop.com) you can create a beautiful image slider effect on your site in 5 minutes: the basics are 2 equal images which overlap each other. When you move the cursor over the image, the first image disappears with a slider effect and the second appears. By experimenting with your images (with transparency, etc. ...) you can achieve very nice effects. A link on the second image directs you to a page.

How does it work?

Start by installing the “Image Slider” stacks and restart RapidWeaver for the new stacks to become available. Switch into edit mode and drag the **image slider** stack into your stacks page. You will see 2 placeholders for images like this:

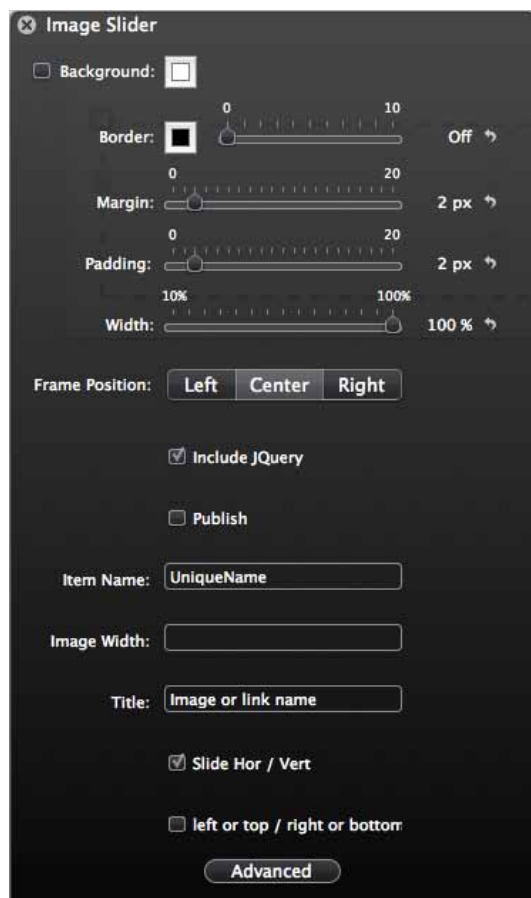


The image placeholder on top refers to the image on the background. The one on the bottom lays on top (when the “Image Slider Script” stack is inserted) of the background image.

Drop the first image (say 400px width by 200px Height) you designed on the top placeholder.
Drop the second image (also 400px by 200px - work with some transparency on this image
-> nice effect) on the bottom placeholder “ **Be creative - The possibilities are endless**”

Now open the inspector window by clicking on the ‘i’ icon. This will reveal the stack inspector:

First check if the images you imported are set to 100% (in the image inspector from the image stack) - this is important !!



Now fill in the “**item name**” of the stack. The item name makes this stack **unique**. So when you enter a second “image slider” stack on the page, you can modify this one separately!

Set a link to the TOP image (like you set a link to a image or text - makes it possible to use lightbox ect.)

Important !!

The image width has to be filled in with the same width as the original image (in this case 400 px - see above)

Give the image a name (replace the “image or link name” default title by your title name).

Choose in witch direction the slider has to move.
(mark ‘slide Hor / vert’ to slide to the **left**)
(mark ‘slide Hor / vert’ and ‘left or top / right or bottom’ to slide to the **right**)
(Unmark both to slide to the **top**)
(Unmark ‘slide Hor / vert’ and mark ‘left or top / right or bottom’ to slide to the **bottom**)

Now, it’s time to mark the checkbox ‘Publish’ and your done !

All the magic happens here. There is nothing more to do.

If you want to modify the images simply unmark the checkbox ‘Publish’
