

# Image Reflection Stack

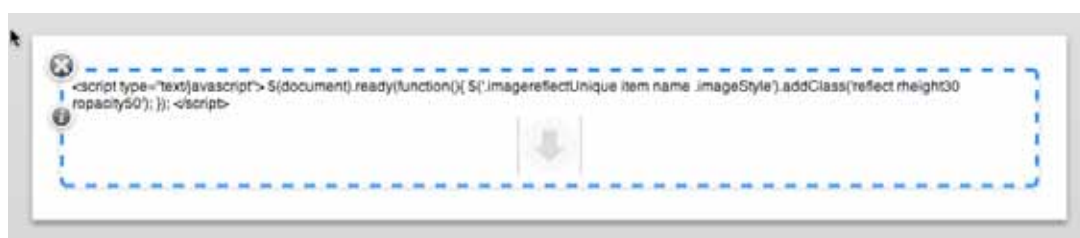

With this brief manual and the movie on my website ([www.idsign-shop.com](http://www.idsign-shop.com)) you can create a beautiful image reflection effect in no time. Just drag the “Image Reflection” stack on the page, drop a image on the placeholder, insert the second “Image Reflection script” stack above the first stack and... your started

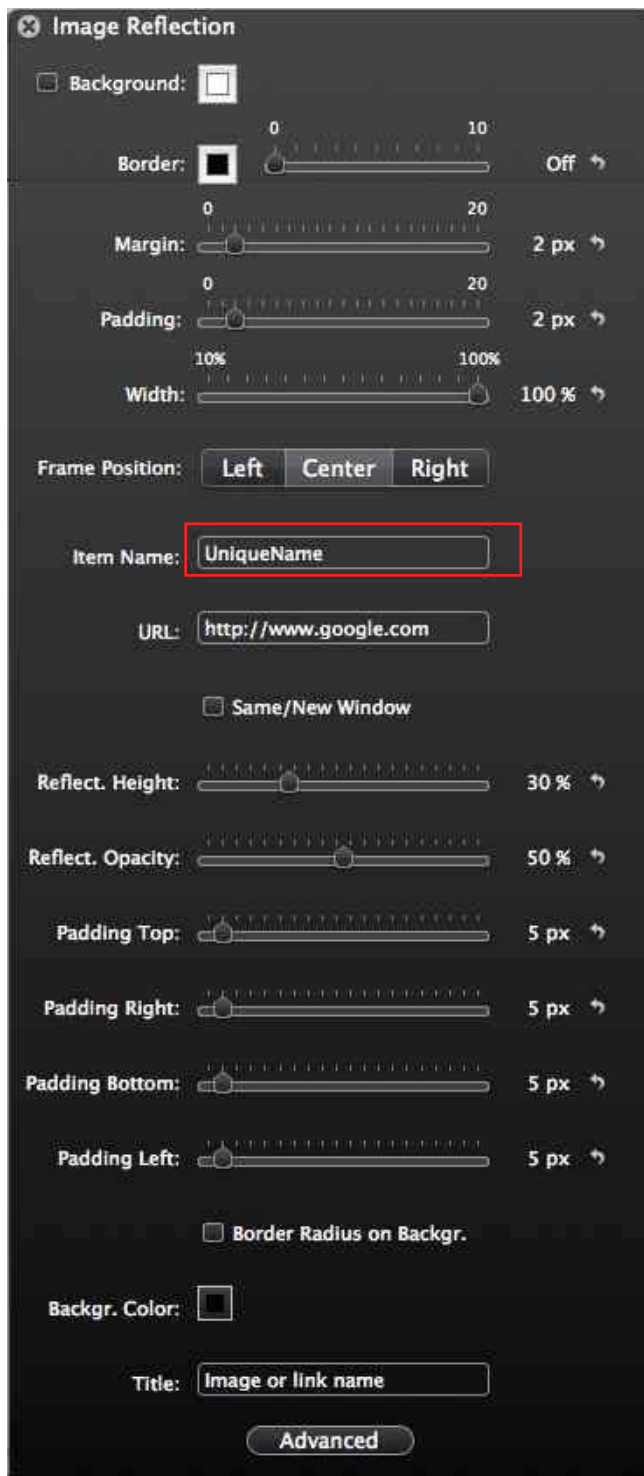
## How does it work?

Start by installing the “Image Reflection” and “Image Reflection Script” stacks and restart RapidWeaver for the new stacks to become available. Switch into edit mode and drag the **image Reflection** stack into your stacks page. You will see this window:



Drop your image on the placeholder and insert the “Image Reflection Script” stack above the “Image Reflection” stack





**First Type in a unique item name if you want to change your image seperatly - this is important !!**

Now fill in a “url” you want to link to. Mark the checkbox to open your linked page in the Same or a New Window.

Play with the Reflection Height and Opacity until you reach the best result.

If you choose to add a background color, you can add a border radius (Only Mozilla browsers). Play with the padding for good positioning.

To finish: give the image a name (replace the “image or link name” default title by your title name).

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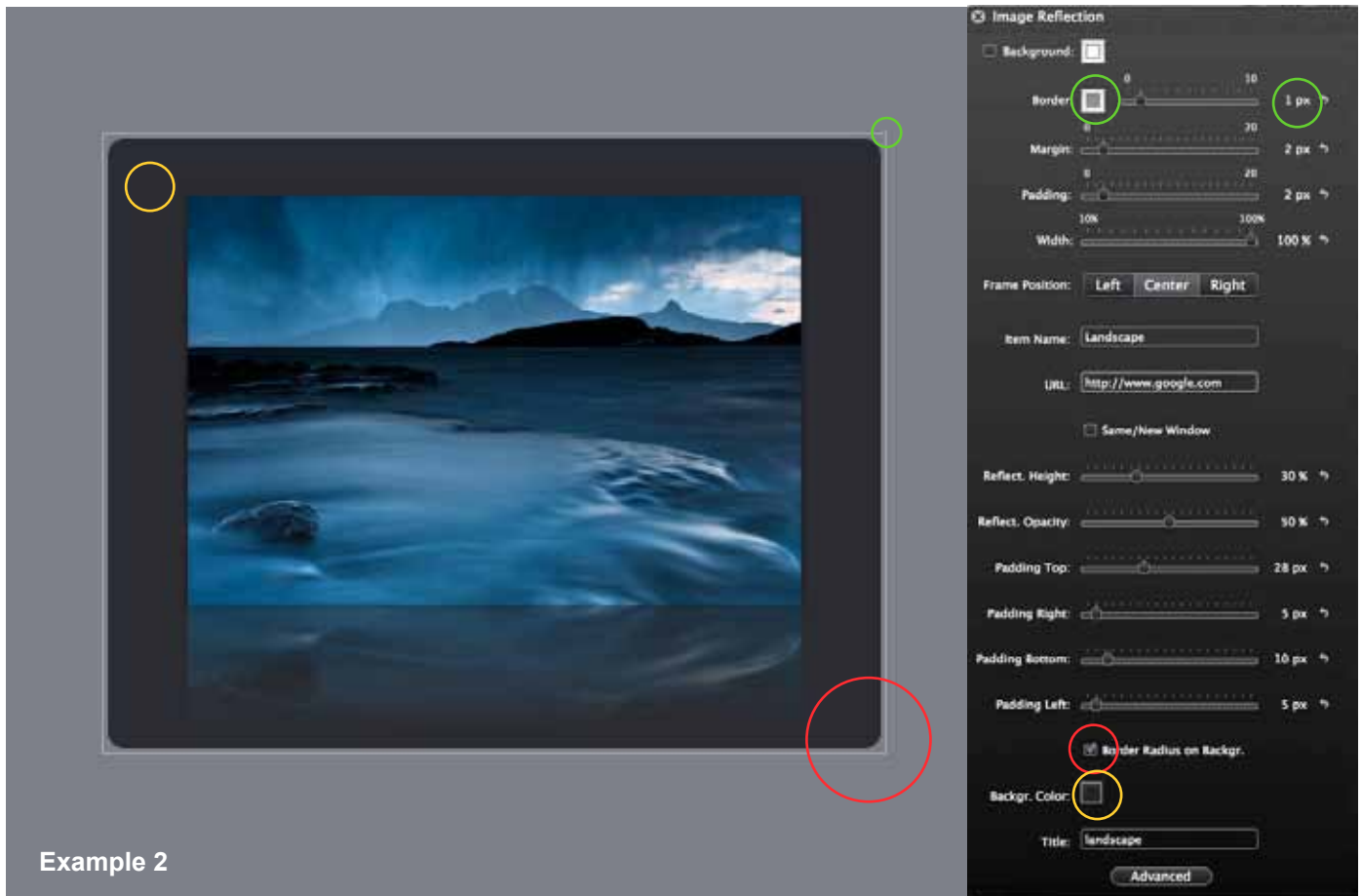
