

New: Sliding Panel Stack

With this brief manual and the movie on my website (www.idsign-shop.com) you can create a nice Sliding panel on your site. Just drop the Sliding Panel stack on your stack page and make your design inside this stack Also remember that the more different types of stacks you add to a page, the more potential there is for conflicts, especially with fancy, animated stacks. This is true for all stacks, not just Sliding Panel ! Don't forget to drop a background image pattern file in your assets and link it in the info panel of the Sliding Panel stack.

How does it work?

Start by installing the "Sliding Panel" stack and restart RapidWeaver for the new stack to become available. Switch into edit mode and drag the "**Sliding Panel**" stack into your stacks page. You will see a placeholder like this:



Design whatever you want inside this stack (avoid using other javascript based stacks!! - could cause problems!!)

IMPORTANT!! Just drag 1 "Sliding Panel" stack on a page !!!

Attention: Some important changes you need to consider

How to use the info panel:

1: **IMPORTANT !!!!**

First complete your design, then mark the checkbox (for publishing !!!)

2: **IMPORTANT !!!!**

Link your background image with the file you already put in your assets window.
FULL PATH

3: If you only want to use a color or want to combine it with a half transparent image, type in the hex. color name (ex: #cccccc). You can see sample color codes here and on many other sites:

4/5: **IMPORTANT !!!!**

Div/Class conflict: If you have a conflict that some of your items appears above the sliding panel type in the div or class name: ex: #navcontainer (if this doesn't work ask your theme developer for a solution)

6: Mark this checkbox if you want a full height on the page of the slider. (Otherwise it's a fluid height)

7: If you choose for a fluid height, use the panel position to position where the panel has to appear.

8: Modify the panel content width from the sliding panel content

9: Choose a border color and choose border right if you use full height. Mark also the border top/bottom for fluid height. And border radius if you want round corners (works only on moz based browsers)

10: Change the color from the content text to match the background (only the color changes)

11: Change the padding

12: Modify the title that will show on the tab

13: Change the background color of the slider tab button

14: Change the text color of the slider tab button

Remember to check the box from step 1 before publishing!



!!!! you have to place the Sliding panel stack always on the bottom of the page in edit mode !!!!
