

# Transition Stack

With this brief manual and the movie on my website ([www.idsign-shop.com](http://www.idsign-shop.com)) you can create beautiful image transition effect on several overlying images. You can insert as many images as you want. Only one generated effect (adaptable) can be set on one image group (grouped by ID)

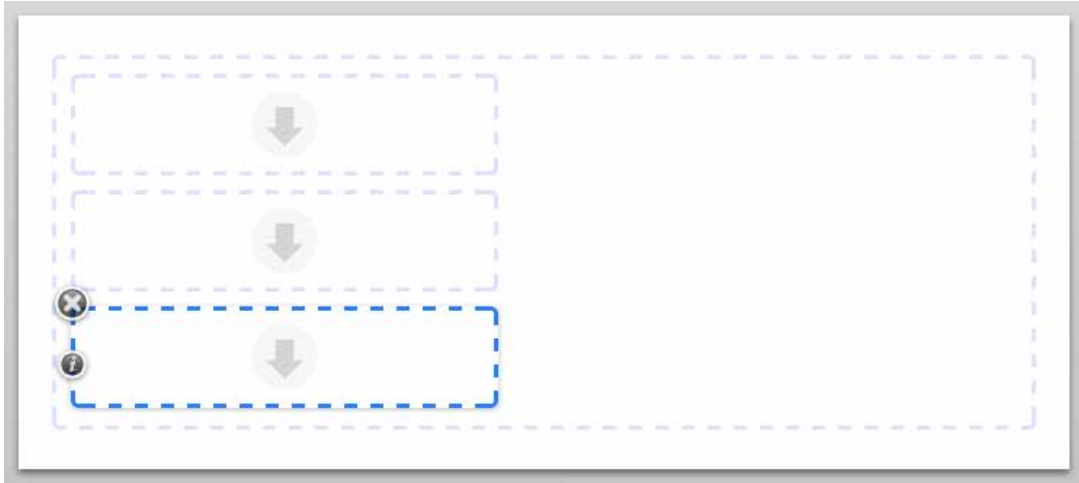
## How does it work?

Start by installing the “Transition” and “Transition Image” stacks and restart RapidWeaver for the new stacks to become available. Switch into edit mode and drag the **Transition** stack into your stacks page. You will see a placeholder like this (the image group is by default floated left - due to technical reasons):



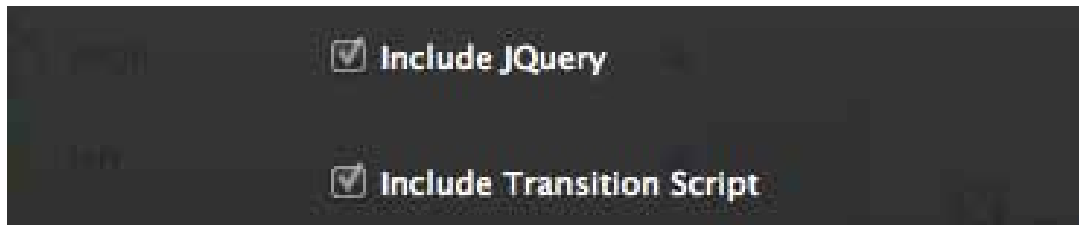
### What's next?

Drop as many "Transition Image" stacks inside the "Transition" stack as you want. Drop inside each image placeholder a image with the same width and height (remember the dimentions - you have to put them also in the "Transition" stack info panel).



## Transition info panel

Include (on your site) only once the JQuery script! If you want to make more then one Transition gallery on 1 page - mark "include Transition script" once!! (so unmark the "include transition script" checkbox on inserting a second "Transition" stack).



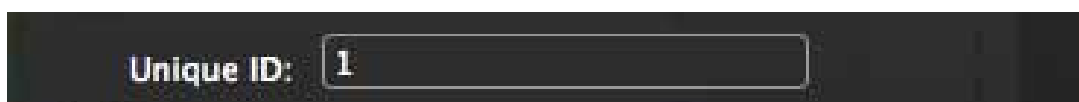
If you want to set a link to your image gallery use this method:

**HREF="http://www.google.com"**

If you don(t want a link or pointer to your image gallery delete this line



The "Unique ID" links your images (images with the same ID set in the "Transition Images" Stack) and preferences (generated effect) for this gallery



**Image Effect:**

You have four options: wave, zipper, curtain and nothing (Use blanc field to make your own effects with "Position" and "Direction" or combine them)

Img Effect:

**Position:**

You have four options: top, bottom, alternate, curtain (play with them together with "direction" - don't forget to delete the basic effect input field - or make a combination)

Position:

**Direction:**

You have six options: left, right, alternate, random, fountain, fountainAlternate (play with them together with "position" - don't forget to delete the basic effect input field - or make a combination))

Direction:

**Image Width:**

Don't forget to set the image width and height (the width and height from the images you dropt in the image placeholders)

**Strips:**

The images are composed with "Strips" effect. Attention the more strips you use the more loading time your images need to build up!

Strips:  20 ↺

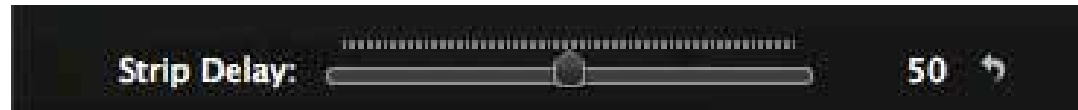
**Delay Between Image:**

Is the time delay (in ms) between the images (to show the next image)

Delay Btw Image:  5000 ↺

**Strip Delay:**

Is the delay time (in ms) between the strips

**Title Opacity:**

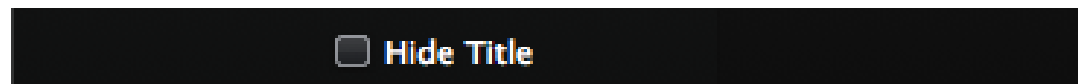
You can control the opacity from the black field (shows up on each picture) behind the titel (To set up a title you have to click on the image and open the image info panel and set the "file Name" and "Alt Tag")

**Title Speed:**

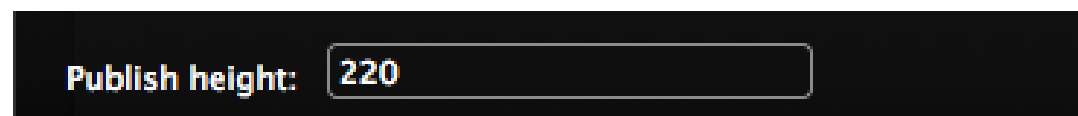
Is the speed (in ms) the tittle appears

**Hide Title:**

If you just want to see the images without a title on the bottom mark this checkbox.

**Publish height:**

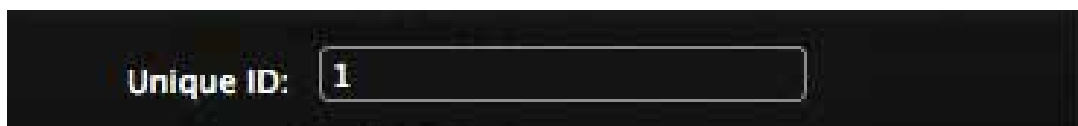
I build this feature in to work cleaner (if you drop in 10 images it becomes a long list). Set this height to the same height as your images if you publish. **Delete this value (in this example 220) if you want to modify your images !**

## Transition Image info panel

Type in on each image the same id to link them with the ID from the script  
Use a differnt ID (for example: 2) for a second Transition gallery on you page and link this one with a new (second) Transition stack (same ID = 2) to link them



# I don't see the full info panel on my screen

E: Drag your rapid weaver screen to let's say half of your desktop window, open the info panel and drag it to the top (don't close it) now click on your rapidweaver window and drag it back to the top (with the info panel still open) so you can see the rest of the info panel on a small screen.

FR: Placer la fenêtre Rapidweaver à mi-hauteur de votre écran. ouvrez le panneau d'information et le faire glisser vers le haut (ne fermez pas) alors cliquer sur la fenêtre de votre RapidWeaver panneau et faites-la glisser en arrière vers le haut (avec le panneau d'informations encore ouvert).
