

# Basic Box Toggler Stack

Made by IDSIGN - [www.idsign-shop.com](http://www.idsign-shop.com)



Basic Box Toggler is an easy and flexible stack for RapidWeaver. With this manual and the movie on my website ([www.idsign-shop.com](http://www.idsign-shop.com)) you can create a beautiful Box Toggler on your site. You can use it to group items/blocks in a category. It's usefull for making a faq page, a product page, a news page and so on. The idea is to structure large pages into groups so when you add a item/block and define it to a specified group you can filter all the blocks with the same id.

## **How does it work?**

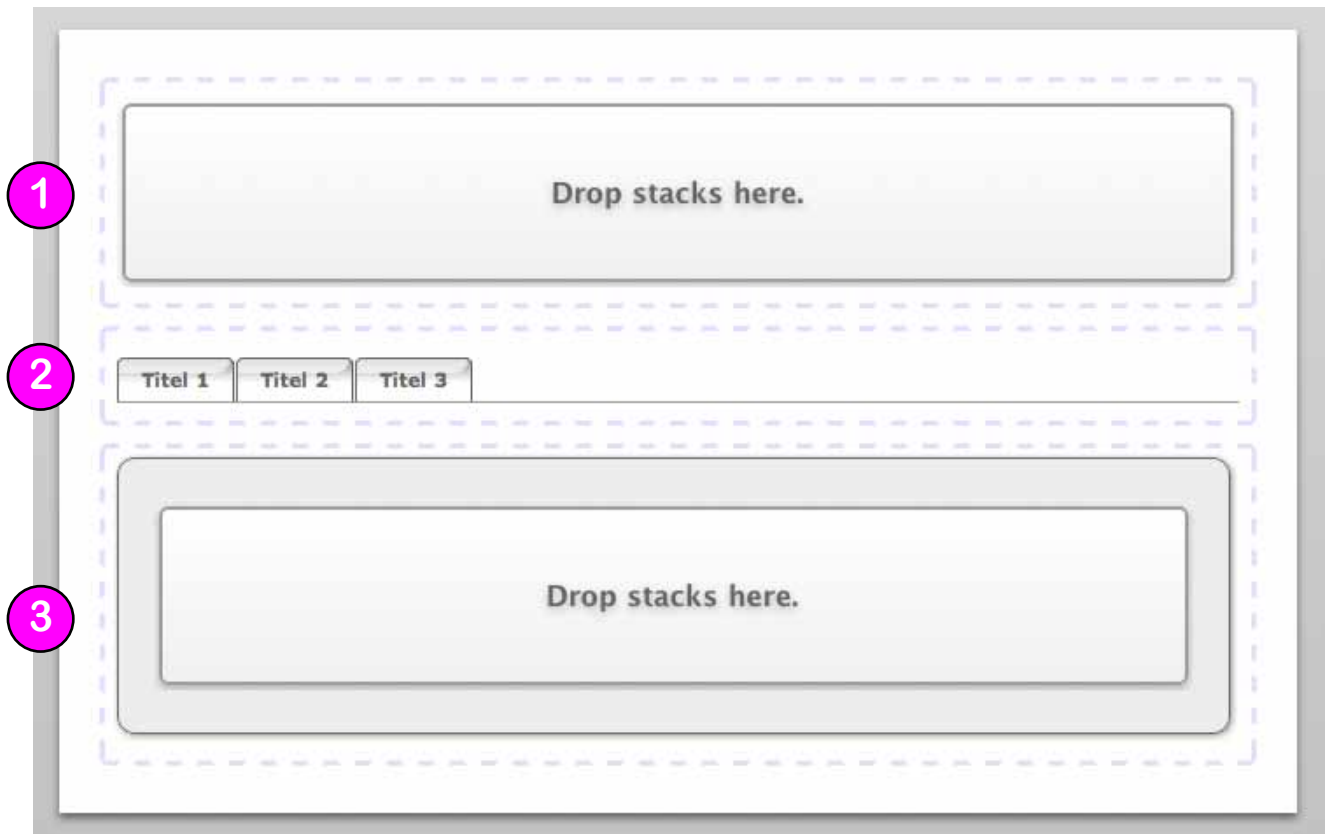
Start by installing the stacks "Basic Box Toggler and Basic Box Block" stack (if you just want clean blocks - see example on my site). You can also install the "Box navigator" or make your own buttons/links (see for more info in this manual).

After you installed the stacks restart RapidWeaver for the new stacks to become available.

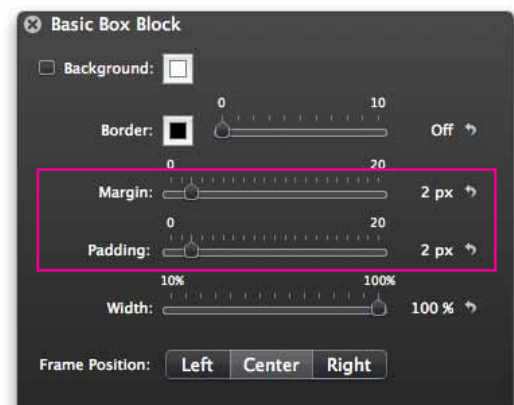
# 1 - STARTING WITH BASIC BOX TOGGLER AND BASIC BOX BLOCK'S

After you drop the Basic Box toggler, Box navigator and Basic Box Blocks on the page you see this appearing on your screen.

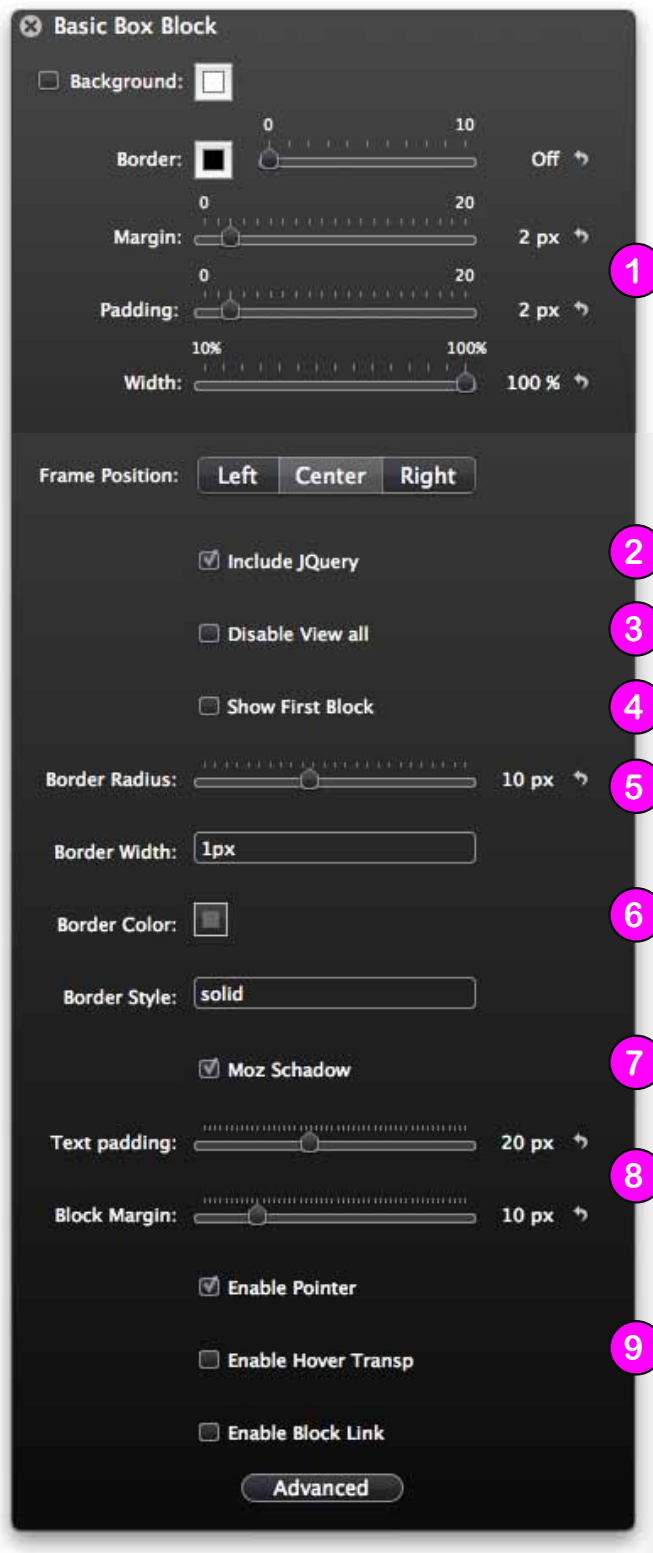
- 1) Is the Basic Box Toggler stack stack that runs the toggler (=script stack)
- 2) Is the Box Navigator (could be replaced with whatever you can set a link on)
- 3) Is the Basic Box Block where you make your design in



You can also drop the Box Navigator (2) inside the Basic Box Toggler (1) --> set margin and padding off on all items! (you can do this in the top of the info panel) It's not necessary but it's nicer



# HOW TO USE THE BASIC BOX TOGGLER INFO PANEL



1) set margin and padding off on all items! (you can do this in the top of the info panel) It's not necessary but it's nicer

2) If you already loaded the JQuery script -> unmark this checkbox

3-4) There are 3 ways to view your start page:  
**a: View all box blocks on page enter**  
When you mark the "Disable View all" checkbox you can use **b** or **c** **Otherwise you leave it unmarkt !!**

**b: View only the first block(s)** -> included and linked to a button with the same id. You can mark the "Show First Block" to start with the first items/blocks open (All blocks which have the same ID as the first button will be shown)

**c: Hide all block(s)**  
Nothing is shown, only when you click on the first button the first blocks will open (it doesn't close anymore only when you entered the page again - it toggle's between the various blocks)

5) Change the border radius from the Basic Box Block (only on Moz based browsers)

6) Style the borders of all blocks at once:  
Border width - For the tickness of the border  
Border color - pick a color  
Border style - could be solid, dashed, dotted, inset, outset, ridge, groove and **none if you don't want to show a border**

7) Moz shadow (only on Moz based browsers)

8) Text padding - padding inside the content block of the box

Block Margin - space between the blocks

9) You can enable or disable a Pointer or/and hover transparency effect or/and block link when you enter your mouse over your Box block's

All settings made in the Box Toggler apply to all Box Block's inserted on your page

## HOW TO USE THE BASIC BOX BLOCK INFO PANEL

1) set margin and padding off on all items! (you can do this in the top of the info panel) It's not necessary but it's nicer

2) **IMPORTANT!!** The block ID you have given has to be the same ID as the button where you want to appear this block (**Don't use spaces in the name !!!**)

3) If you want to set a link to the Box block's you have to mark first the "Enable Block Link" in the Box Toggler info panel.

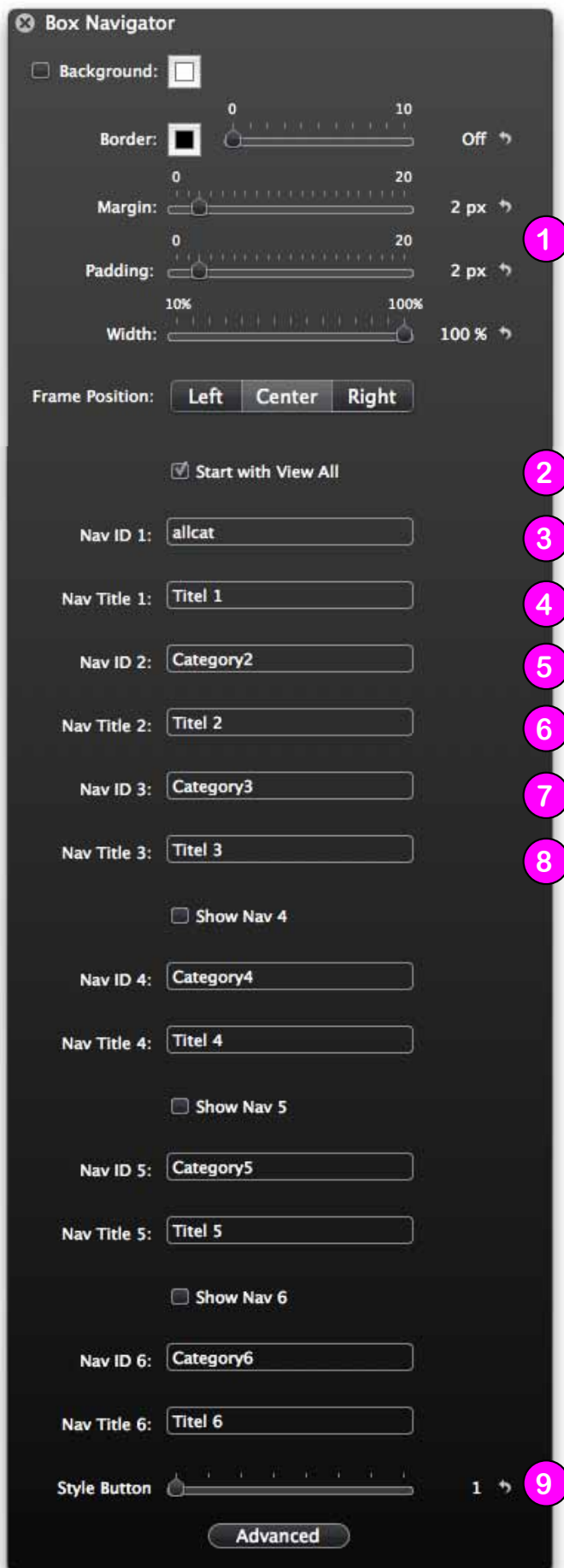
4) If you want a **fluid height** leave this input field **blank**. If you want a **fixed height** type into this field for example: **200px**

5) Give your Box Block a color (transparency not available) or link a image pattern to it (look at point 6)

6) Put a image in the page info - header - Assets and link it

**Each Box block can be modified independent so you can give for example all Box blocks with the ID Sport the same content background color or image (More examples on [www.idsign-shop.com](http://www.idsign-shop.com))**

# HOW TO USE THE BOX NAVIGATOR INFO PANEL



1) set margin and padding off on all items! (you can do this in the top of the info panel) It's not necessary but it's nicer

**Explanation how the Box Navigator works:** The Box Toggler works with 2 types of ID's and Classes. In this Box navigator the class elements are already defined so you only have to type in a ID (remember point 2 in the Box Blocks info panel)

**A:** Only use the "allcat" ID (and class "current" if you make your own buttons) If you want to show all block's on page enter. (in this case mark "Start with View All" in the Box navigator and unmark "Disable view all" - in the Box Toggler info panel)

**B:** Use the ID you have given to the Box Block (remember point 2 in the Box Blocks info panel) (and the class "filter" if you make your own links) **More info see next page**

2) Mark checkbox If you want to View all items on page enter

3) **IMPORTANT!!** If you want to start with view all blocks type "allcat" in the Nav ID 1 input field. If you don't start with view all type in the first ID you already defined in one of the Box blocks ID's.

4) Title of the button (When you start with view all you best give the button a name like: All categories or View all (or whatever you want)

5, 6, 7, 8 ) ID has to be the same as some items from the Box Block's ID you already defined (NO SPACES). Title - whatever you want.

9) Some Predefined button styles (Color change on hover). But you can use whatever you want.

**The Box Navigator is NOT a necessary stack. You can use other buttons or text or images to link the blocks - More info next page.**

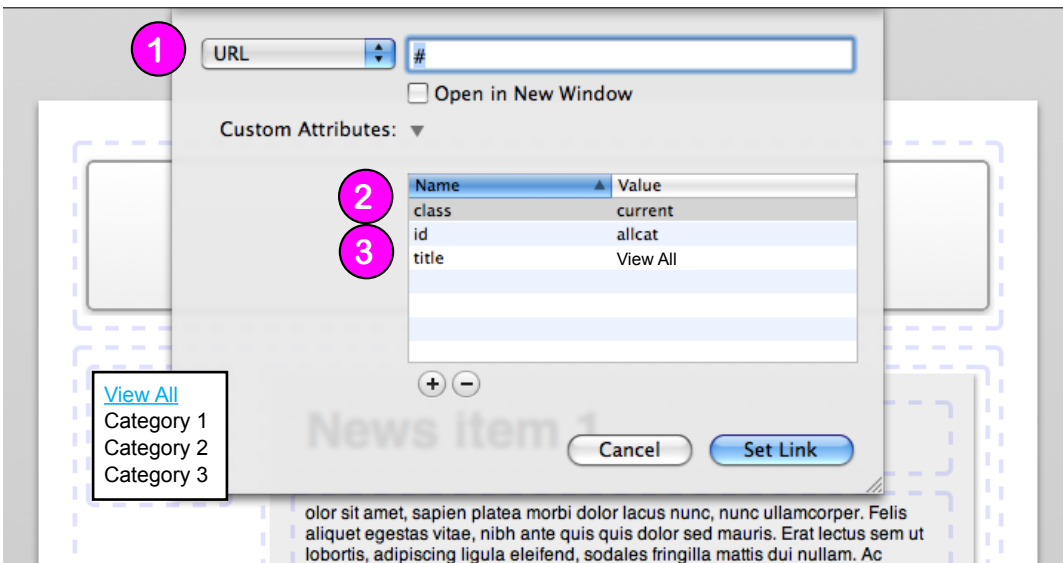
# HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN NAVIGATOR

(START WITH VIEW ALL BOX BLOCKS ON PAGE ENTER)

All items on which you can set a link to can be used to navigate the blocks. In this case i used text and want to start with all blocks shown on the page (on page enter). I already inserted some Box Blocks stacks and gave them the ID category1, category2, category3, ... Next step: i made a link to the first text (just a title) [View All](#) (which are going to show all box blocks) and open the link inspector (see image)

- 1) Place a # where you normally put a url
- 2) Click on + to add a extra field and type in: class (name) and current (value)
- 3) Click on + to add a extra field and type in: id (name) and allcat (value)

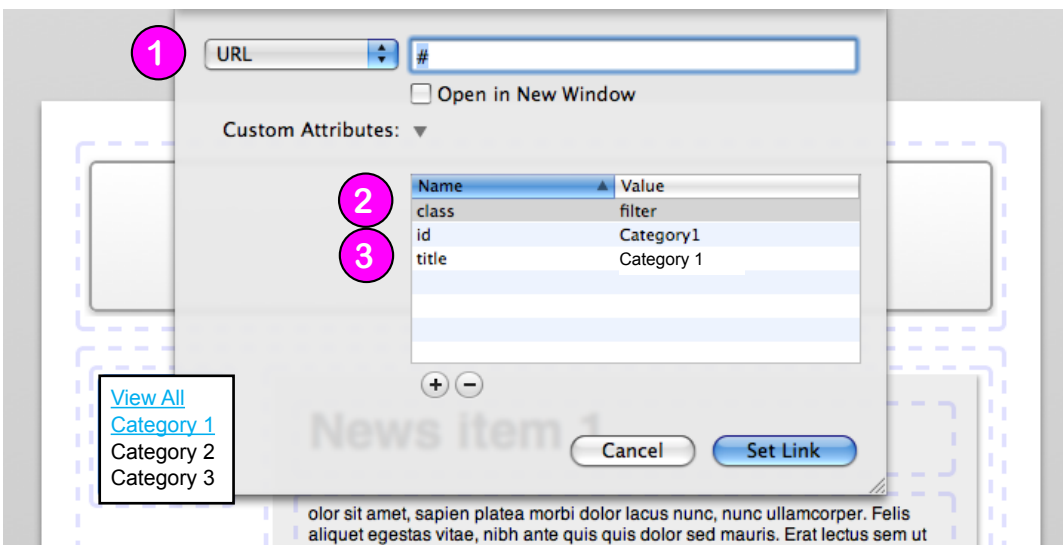
**This settings will trigger the first button (link) to show all box block's**



Next: Click on the second item you want to make a link of. Make a link and open the link inspector

- 1) Place a # where you normally put a url
- 2) Click on + to add a extra field and type in: class (name) and filter (value)
- 3) Click on + to add a extra field and type in: id (name) and Category1 (value)

**This settings will trigger the second button with the title [Category 1](#) and the ID Category1 (NO SPACES). All Box Blocks with this ID (Category1) will open (toggle) and will be shown only when you click on the button (in this case the text: Category 1).**



**So Each button has a ID which correspondent to one or more box blocks with the same ID**

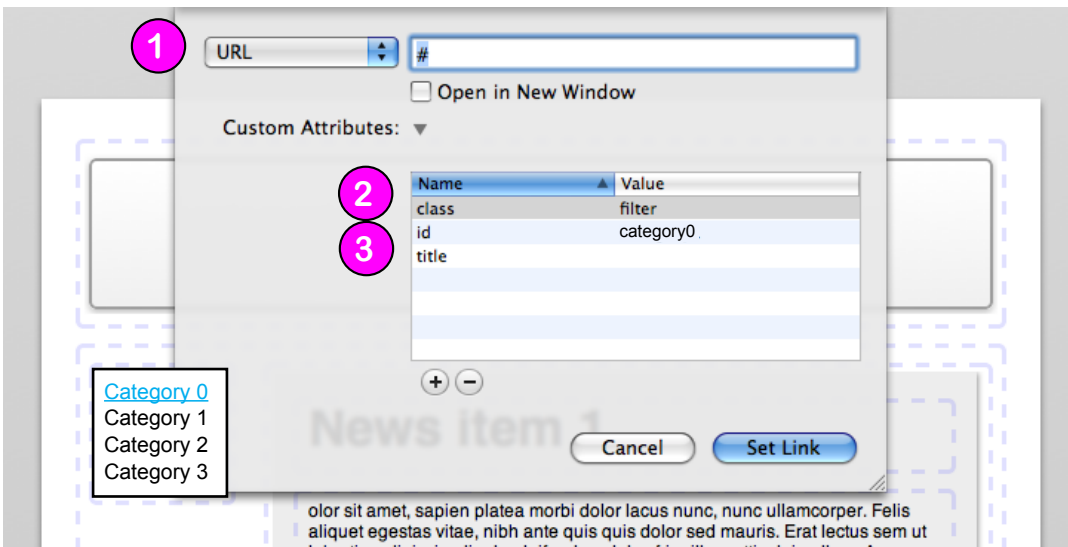
# HOW TO MAKE YOUR OWN NAVIGATOR

(START WITH A SELECTED GROUP OF BOX BLOCKS ON PAGE ENTER)

All items on which you can set a link to can be used to navigate the blocks. In this case i used text and want to show only the first blocks link to the first button. I allready inserted Box Blocks stacks and gave them the ID category0, category1, category2, category3, ... Next step: i made a link to the first text (just a title) [Category 0](#) (which are going to show just those box blocks with the same ID) and open the link inspector (see image)

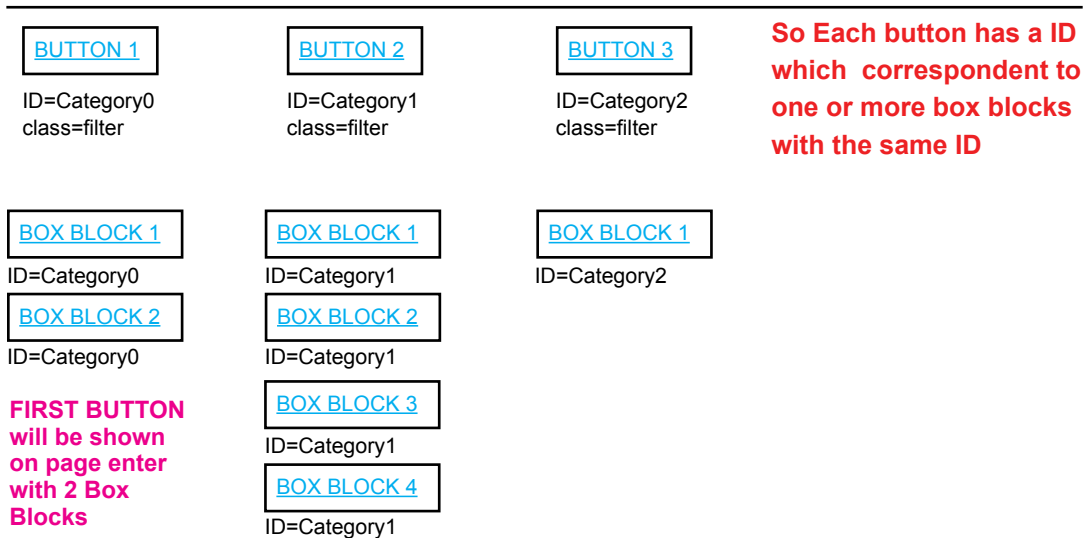
- 1) Place a # where you normally put a url
- 2) Click on + to add a extra field and type in: class (name) and filter (value)
- 3) Click on + to add a extra field and type in: id (name) and category0 (value)

**This settings will trigger the first button (link) to show all box block's with the ID category0**



Next step: Repeat this for each button. Class is always filter and the ID depend on the ID you have allready set to the Box Block(s).

## EXAMPLE: SCHEMATIC OVER VIEW



**If you just want to open your page with only the buttons (no box blocks shown) Unmark the checkbox "Show first block" in the info panel from the "Box toggler" stack. Only use this feature with these (class filter) settings !!!! (USELESS when you want to view all box blocks explained on previous page)**
